Minutes, General Meeting

March 10, 2012

The regular meeting of the club was opened at 7:03 p.m. by the president, Tom Kaiser. There were sixteen members and one guest present. A quorum was present.

Minutes of the January 14, 2012 meeting were approved as printed in SpotNews.

The treasurer, Mike Hennessey, reported that dues had been received from eighty-nine members and more are coming in. The report of the treasurer will be filed for audit. The treasurer also reported that he is looking into a substitute for PayPal.

Reports of Committees:

Obedience Trial: Kris Carlsson indicated that some workers had been unable to attend, due to weather, but volunteers stepped in to help. Finances were tight, but the quilt raffle helped. Despite some problems, people were complimentary and expressed the hope that the trial would be held again next year. Kris Carlsson suggested that she meet with Nancy Reyes about holding the obedience trial at For Your Canine next year and that she ask Nancy if she would serve as secretary.

Meg Hennessey moved, and it was seconded, that CDC have an obedience trial in January, 2013. The motion carried.

Specialty: The premium for the specialty on June 8-9, 2012 has been sent to Roy Jones, but nothing has yet been received from them. The specialty will be publicized in five surrounding states; we will use CDC, DCA and AKC lists. Kris Benoit will receive trophy donations. We will plan to do a ringside pot-luck on Friday evening, but there will be no food provided on Saturday.

Ways and Means: Tom Kaiser announced that there were two contestants for the chili cook-off being held tonight.

Unfinished Business:

Fun Match: This item had been tabled at the last meeting for consideration tonight. Meg Hennessey said that she will research a date for this event and possible activities that could be held in conjunction with it.

Holiday Brunch: This will be on December 30, 2012. It will be announced in Spot News.

New Business:

2013 Specialty: It was moved by Meg Hennessey and seconded, that we hold a specialty in June 2013 in conjunction with the Wheaton Kennel Club. This would be on a Friday and Saturday.

The motion carried.

It was moved by Meg Hennessey and seconded, that we invite Kathy Aycock to judge sweeps on one of the days of the specialty, to be determined. The motion carried.

Other judges will be needed for this specialty. This will be discussed in May.

Sue Buse has resigned as editor of Spot News, effective immediately. We will need a new editor; anyone interested should contact our president.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
