(American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.50 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 1, Section 5). There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.

The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

NOTE: Show Secretary accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (rules) of the American Kennel Club. In the event of a discrepancy in these entry form instructions, Agreement and rules versus the text within the entry form you sign and submit, the AKC Agreement, entry form instructions and rules in effect at the time these entries close will take precedence.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event a severe weather or tornado warning is issued for the immediate area, Site Security will notify the Purina Farms management team. The team will notify guests of an impending weather event via the property-wide public address system. Public service announcements should also come via the storm siren and announcements. Guests will be asked to seek cover in designated areas marked as severe weather shelter areas inside the Purina Farms facilities (those in the outdoor event areas should seek cover in one of the indoor facilities on the property). Areas at the Purina Event Center include the Gateway Hall, restrooms, South stairwell and the Great Hall if necessary. At the Visitor Center, this includes the bathrooms, indoor theater and the hallway near the front information desk. After the weather event ends, Purina Farms management teams will announce all clear.

If weather is extreme after-hours, then security will unlock the Purina Event Center to allow overnight guests to come into the building with dogs at any time. The service center is also open 24/7 for campers to seek shelter. Should the weather look threatening, Purina Farms Security will go around the lots to notify overnight guests to seek shelter.

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES

### Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog & Bitch Entries

The first place Winner of each of these classes, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed

**Veteran Classes DCA NATIONAL** • A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches.

Veteran (8 years and under 10 years of age) ● Veteran (10 + years and over of age)

**Veteran Classes REGIONAL SPECIALTIES** • A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches.

Veteran (7 years and under 10 years of age) ● Veteran (10 + years and over of age)

Under “AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows,” Chapter 11, Section 8, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

**FOR THESE DCA CONFORMATION EVENTS SCHEDULED JUNE 18-20, THE AGE OF THE DOG ON JUNE 19 DETERMINES THE APPROPRIATE AGE-RELATED CLASS. THIS APPLIES TO SWEEPSTAKES, FUTURITY, REGULAR CLASSES AND VETERAN CLASSES AT THE NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY.**

### Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries DCA NATIONAL ONLY

As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class – National Only** • For Stud Dog and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed or may be entered in Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Stud only to be judged on the merits of the Get.

While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy or the standard of the breed.

**Brood Bitch Class – National Only** • Same as above except Substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Offspring for Get.

AKC rules Applying to Dog shows, Chapter 11, Section 8, provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and spayed bitches may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

**Brace Class – National Only** • Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST

be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace # 1", "Brace # 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

**Award of Merit—All Events** • The judge, at his/her discretion may award up to 10% rounded up to the nearest whole number, of all dogs in the ring which are eligible for Best of Breed to be considered for an Award of Merit; the Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best of Opposite and Best of Winners are not eligible for an Award of Merit.

**Special Attraction—National Only** • Following Best of Breed the American Kennel Club offers, at the Dalmatian Club of America 2025 Specialty (only), one free litter registration to the **Best Bred By Exhibitor**. The Dalmatian Club of America will offer a rosette to the winner.

The winner will be awarded in the same manner as National Owner Handled Series Best of Breed. Exhibitors must declare their dog in Bred-By-Exhibitor eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the catalog. There will be no additional entry fee for this competition.

**Remember to Check the Bred-By-Exhibitor Box.**

**3 Point Major Reserve** • At the National Specialty and at the Regional Specialties, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

## AKC NATIONAL-OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The **AKC National Owner-Handled Series** will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to professional handlers to leave the ring and then the judge will select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

**Professional handlers** are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. ## FUTURITY REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION - NATIONAL

Dogs shown in Futurity must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry forms. Entrants may be shown by owners or agents. Indicate your Futurity Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." The Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. Futurity is open to dogs & bitches from properly nominated litters pursuant to DCA Futurity Rules and to dogs and bitches that have been properly nominated prior to four months of age. The breeder of the dog or bitch must be a member in good standing of the DCA. The name and AKC registration number of each entry, as well as the owner's name and address, must have been conveyed to the Futurity Chair at least one month prior to the date of the Futurity.

### 2025 Futurity Classes

**Only puppies whelped between December 19, 2023, and December 19, 2024, will be eligible for the 2025 Futurity.**

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:  
Junior 6 Months & Under 9 Months ● Junior 9 Months & Under 12 Months  
Senior 12 Months & Under 15 Months ● Senior 15 Months & Under 19 Months

### Division of Fees as Prizes

The fee to enter a puppy in Futurity shall be a total of \$42.00, \$10.00 of which shall be considered the sustaining fee and the remaining \$32.00 is the actual entry fee to enter the class and will be retained by the superintendent and the Club for show expenses. The Futurity Purse is the total of all nomination fees and sustaining fees minus the 20% that is deducted from the total Purse to be used for Futurity expenses.

20% of the total nomination and sustaining fee purse will be retained by the Club for Futurity expenses.

60% of the total purse will be divided according to the percentage of the total entry represented by the number of dogs in each class.

All of which the recorded breeder is to be awarded 60% and the recorded owner is to be awarded 40% of each individual monetary award in each class

20% of the Total purse will be awarded as follows:

Best in Futurity.....	50%
Best Junior Futurity.....	25%
Best Senior in Futurity.....	25%

The 50% Best in Futurity Award will be divided 50% to the recorded breeder and 50%

to the recorded owner. The 25% Best Senior in Futurity and Best Junior in Futurity Awards will be divided 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner, and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating for each winner. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Futurity monetary awards will be made to the winner by the DCA Futurity Chair, subsequent to his/her certification of winners.

Limited crating space will be provided in the Great Hall near the rings **ONLY** for Agility, Obedience, Rally and Scent Work Exhibitors on the days of those events - Monday through Wednesday. **Place crates ONLY on installed plastic.** These crates **MUST BE REMOVED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THESE EVENTS ON WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON.**

- Grooming area must be kept clean. All garbage should be placed in the proper receptacles.
- Excessive barking will not be tolerated. Crating is close to a ring, and it is not fair for barking dogs to interrupt judging or disturb the dogs in the ring. We will implement a three-strike rule, and all excessive barking dogs will be asked to be removed.
- Reserved space will be strictly enforced. Space size will be reserved in the order the reservation is received. Make your Reservation using the Store located on the DCA Website. Reservations will close on Monday, June 2, 2025, at 9 pm Pacific. Monies will not be refunded & reservations cannot be changed after closing. Confirmations will be published in a listing of all reservations along with a map on the website following the closing of entries. No confirmations will be mailed or emailed. # AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

### AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
